





MAYARDAU AOP Bordeaux

The Bordeaux region is located on the Atlantic side of the left and right rivers of the Gironde. On 119,000 ha and more than 60 appellations, the Bordeaux region represents the largest French AOP vineyard.

Divided into five sub-regions: Médoc, Graves, Entre-deux-Mers, Right Bank and Sauternes, the region benefiting from a temperate oceanic climate. Its soils are rather clay-limestone, sands and gravel.

The main reds in the region are Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc.
